2008 LEXUS ADELAIDE TO PORT LINCOLN BLUE WATER CLASSIC

SA's premier ocean race will be held for the 59th time today and tomorrow (Friday-Saturday). This is a race of 156 nautical miles with competitors departing Outer Harbour in two stages, Cruisers depart at 10am and racers at 3pm.

One of the highlights will be the match race between interstate maxi Skandia and local speed catamaran Raw Nerve. Last year's handicap winner, As Good As It Gets, with Dick Fidock at the helm, will be hard to beat again, as will Renegade, with Bob Francis, who is racing for the 40th time in the event.

Race conditions will affect times with teams hoping winds will turn to south-east by race time.
